Indemnity:

The permit holder must indemnify the State acting through the Environmental Protection Agency (including employees and agents of the State) from and against any loss, damage or expense (including legal costs), arising from any claim, demand, action, suit or proceeding that may be made or brought by any person against the State in respect of:

- (a) the death of or injury to any person; and
- (b) the loss of or damage to any property

Where such death, injury, loss or damage arises out of or in connection with the permit holder's activity in an area managed by the Environmental Protection Agency and is caused by the negligent act or omission of the permit holder or an employee, member, agent, invitee or client of the permit holder.

Provided that the permit holder shall not be liable for any liability or loss to the extent that it is the fault of the State. Where negligence is found to have been contributory, each party shall bear full responsibility in accordance with the party's fault.

The permit holder must advise the chief executive in writing of any death, injury, loss or damage described in clause 1.1(a) and (b) immediately upon the permit holder becoming aware of such death, injury, loss or damage.

Release and discharge:

The permit holder releases and discharges the State acting through the Environmental Protection Agency (including employees and agents of the State) from any claim, demand, action, suit or proceeding which, but for the provisions of this condition, may be brought against or made upon the State by the permit holder.

CERTIFICATION: It is hereby declared that the information contained in this application is true, complete and correct. It is understood that if the information provided in this application is incorrect or misleading, an offence may be committed against the Act and (1) the permit may not be granted; (2) the permit may be invalid and/or (3) the permit may be cancelled.
